Materials:

- water color paper or card stock - I'll be folding a piece to make a card measuring about 8" x 8" but you can choose any size that you like. Just make sure your quilt pattern that you choose will fit.
- glue stick
- scissors and/or cutting blade
- tracing paper
- pencil
- bone folder
- artist's tape or masking tape
- a landscape or scene from a magazine that represents the moment you wish to share. It just needs to be at least as large as your chosen quilt pattern.
- any clippings, paper scraps, photos or other materials you might want to have along
- your supplied printable quilt patterns
